Graduation

The 2021 Graduation is scheduled for Wednesday, June 9th. We hope to be able to celebrate with the children as they complete their Greek School year.

Early Dismissal/Pick-Up

If any parent would like to pick up their child at an earlier time than dismissal, we ask that parents write a note to the teacher letting them know that they will be leaving early. No parent will be allowed to enter the school at the time of dismissal. We ask that all parents are prompt at pick-up at 6:30 p.m. A teacher will be assigned at dismissal before and after school hours for approximately 10-15 minutes.

Greek School Supplies

The Church has very generously purchased school supplies and storage boxes for each child this year. They will be given everything they need to be able to complete their work in school. These storage boxes will be disinfected after usage and stored in a designated space in their classrooms with their names on them. The students will use them weekly and return them to their designated storage areas. These storage boxes and supplies will not be permitted to be taken home. Students will be required to arrive in school with their Greek School books each week. New books will be distributed within the month of October.

Masks

As per the Archdiocese Guidelines, all students are required to wear a mask to school. Please have your child arrive at school wearing a mask and remind him/her to please keep it on during all times.

Access to Ellinopoula Software

On the day that students are not at the Greek School for in-person learning, students will participate in one day of remote learning. The learning will become possible via a Greek internet program called Ellinopoula. The Ellinopoula program offers Greek school lessons, grammar exercises, reading passages and games that will help the students practice the lesson they learned during in-person learning. A teacher will not be live during this practice session. Our teachers will administer the lessons and direct the students as to which lessons they should complete on their remote learning day. Upon receiving registration material for each child, the church will purchase the Ellinopoula Software for each of our registered students. In October, parents will be receiving accessibility instructions that will be needed for the one day of remote learning which is now a part of the Greek School program. Please remember to register your child so that we know how many students will need to gain access.

Greek School Rules

Due to new Covid-19 Guidelines, students will not be permitted to roam around the building freely or to visit the bathroom more than one student at a time. The Greek School is taking all the necessary precautions to ensure our children's safety and we ask that all students adhere to the rules and regulations of the Greek School.

Welcome to the 2020-2021 school year at Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox School! Along with the Parish Council and the Greek School Board, I would like to extend my gratitude for your support this coming year.

We are thrilled that our students will be returning to Holy Trinity Greek School and we are looking forward to working with the children beginning on Wednesday, September 30^{th} .

The Greek school teachers and our Director, K. Eleni Limberis, have been working very diligently to schedule the grades on the following days for in-person learning:

Grades 2, 3, 4 & 8 will meet on Mondays from 4:30-6:30 p.m. Grades 1, 5, 6 & 7 will meet on Wednesdays from 4:30-6:30 p.m.

On the day that the students are not at the Greek School for in-person learning, Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church has decided that we will offer one day of remote learning. This learning will become possible via a Greek internet program called Ellinopoula. Ellinopoula offers Greek school lessons, grammar exercises, reading passages and games that will help the students practice the lesson they learned during in-person learning. A teacher will not be live during this practice session. Our teachers will administer the lessons and direct the students as to which lessons they should complete on their remote learning day. The teacher will then monitor the work they have completed later in the week. Access to this program will become available in October.

We appreciate your support as we continue to expand and grow our afternoon Greek School program. Please understand that while the Church is covering the expense of this new digital learning platform, there are still increased costs to operate Greek School including the purchase of teacher computers, internet accessibility, and training.
